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SAXE & STROPP LEATHER

Leather is a natural living material that requires maintenance and becomes even more beautiful if properly cared for over time. For regular cleaning, use a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush. If a more thorough clean is required, we recommend using a solution of 50 millilitres of soap flakes mixed with 1 litre of warm water. When the water is at room temperature, smear the foam over the entire piece of leather with a soft cloth. Take care to only use the foam as the leather must not be saturated. Once the leather is dry, it can be polished with a soft cotton cloth. Please note, your leather has already been treated and you should avoid cleaning it unless absolutely necessary. Take care not to place the leather in direct sunlight and extreme heat. Avoid the use of cleaning agents and do not use sharp objects on the leather.

ML42

For the black variant, wipe with a wet cotton cloth. The ML42 in oak can be treated with vegetable soap flakes or wood oil. Please note that using wood oil can alter the color of the wood, resulting in a darker, warmer tone.

FRAME

When cleaning your Frame box, please make sure to clean it with a dry or very slightly damp cloth only. Do not use soap or excessive water. Keep your Frame box away from high and low temperatures and extreme changes in humidity. As wood veneer is a living material, it is liable to react when directly exposed to heat, oils, fat and moisture. Please do not place your Frame box next to or in the flow of an air-conditioning unit or heater as this may cause the veneer to crack. Maximum weight 35 kg.

TWIN TABLES

Copper and brass are materials that develop patina, meaning that the surface of the Twin tabletop will change character as a result of time and usage. Copper and brass first develop a dark patina and will later become coated with a greenish-blue pigment known as verdigris. Fingerprints and surface patterns will appear more quickly as patina in areas where objects are placed on the table.

To clean brass and copper tabletops simply wipe with a dry cloth or use a non-abrasive formulation Brasso. But please note that brass with the use of Brasso will become a cooler, more matte colour. Make sure that none of the polishing liquid for the burnished copper and brass tabletop touches the reverse side, as this can stain the surface and leave obvious traces on the other tabletop.

To clean tabletops:
For white, oak, black & misty green veneer tabletops, wipe with a moist cloth.

TWIN BOOKCASE

Wipe with a wet cotton cloth.

SHEEPSKIN (TEXTILE)

In order to preserve the original condition of your skin, vacuum clean and air regularly. Spots should immediately be soaked with water. Clean with a sponge, luke warm water and a mild wool shampoo. No bleaching, no ironing. Direct sunlight can cause color changes in the wool. Sheepskin is a natural product, which means the color, texture and length of the wool fibres may vary from product to product.

REMIX, FIORD AND HALLINGDAL (TEXTILE)

Vacuum the fabric regularly.
